"Has law enforcement stored photos of your license plate?"

Contact Your Local Law Enforcement Agency!

You can contact your local law enforcement agency to find out if they have records of where your vehicle has been and when! Such requests must be made in person or by mail. If you send the request by mail, you must include a copy of your driver's license or other identification.

Here is a sample for a request by mail:

Dear Chief/Sheriff _____:

Pursuant to the Government Data Collection and Dissemination Act, Va. Code § 2.2-3806 and the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, Va. Code §§ 2.2-3700 et seq., I am writing to request copies of all records of my vehicle (License Plate Virginia [NUMBER]), including any date, time, and location information, collected by any Automated License Plate Reader. Please also send me all information about the nature of the sources of the information, and the names of any recipients of the information. A copy of my driver's license is enclosed.
