

Charlottesville and Albemarle Raise Taxes Again

Charlottesville City Council voted to raise the meals tax by 1%. Combined with the city sales tax the tax on meals will now be 10.3%

Albemarle Board of Supervisors raised taxes for the second year in a row. The 2014 rate of 79.9 was raised to 82.9 for 2015. The Board of Supervisors raised taxes more than the professional non-partisan County Executive asked.
